My husband Bernard and I bought our first Wolf-hound from the Sanctuary kennel of Margaret Harrison and May Atfield in 1968. Our foundation bitch joined us from the Brabyns kennel of Sue Hudson in 1970 and we registered our kennel name, Braehead, a few months later. All Braehead hounds go back to these two in one way or another.

I started judging in the late 70s and was passed to award CCs in the breed in 1986 and have done so many times since, including Crufts in 1998. I have judged the breed at Championship level in Europe and the States and have judged many other breeds at Open Show level, also Group and BIS. I also judge Otterhounds.

Life member and past committee member of the Irish Wolfhound Club (UK)

Founder member and current committee member of the Irish Wolfhound Society (UK)

Founder member of the Irish Wolfhound Health Group and still serving.

Past committee member of the Otterhound Club (UK) I write the Breed Notes for Our Dogs weekly paper and have done since 1982 and have written many articles for them and other breed publications. I have given talks on the history of the breed and its relevance to the Standard.

Judges' Comments

A big thank you to the BC Branch for honouring me with this appointment. I was royally looked after and entertained and thoroughly enjoyed my stay in Canada.

First of all, a few observations - I have not mentioned bites in my critique as they were all correct, so a blanket "good bite" can be taken for all. Secondly, I was surprised to find two bitches in season being shown. This is generally frowned on in the UK as a bitch in season will be feeling very vulnerable and will not show to her best advantage. More seriously, males can be badly affected and will certainly behave erratically and may lose a place because of this. However far away you keep the bitch from other exhibits before entering the ring, Wolfhounds have a very keen sense of smell and delicious wafts will reach them, wherever they are on the show ground. To spoil another exhibitor's chances, however unintentionally, is just not on. Lastly, I was horrified to find a bitch six weeks in whelp being exhibited. Leaving aside the fact that she could not be shown - and therefore judged - to her full potential, the health implications for both the bitch and her litter are serious.


