In 1968 my husband Leif & I started to talk about getting an Irish Wolfhound, but it was not until 1971 we actually made this dream come true.



His name was Ljunas Peter Pan, a puppy with mostly Irish lines, a son of Ch Boroughbury Paddy Boy of Brabyns.

Our 2nd IW, and the one that really opened our eyes for the breed, we bought 1972 from Mrs Carin Lindhé, Mountebanks kennels. Donovan, as he was called, was a very successful show dog and IW of the year in Sweden for three years in a row, a record still standing.

In 1975 we had the fortune to be able to buy a bitch puppy from Mrs Jenkins - Eaglescrag Hannah. Hannah became our foundation bitch & our first wolfhound litter was born 1977. Hannah was an outstanding brood bitch, especially the combination with our Ch Eaglescrag Viking produced a number of champions.

Among them our late Ch Wolf Tone Gylla, who came to be the most famous of our wolfhound breeding. Gylla started her show career by being BIS puppy under Miss Mary Jane Ellis, and at that same show Gylla's father Ch Eaglescrag Viking was BIS under Mrs Florence Nagle, what a day! Gylla was BIS at The Swedish National Specialty four times under legendary judges: Miss Elisabeth Murphy, Mr Bill Mariott, Mr Sam Ewing III and Mr Ron Baird. BOS for Mr Rathbone-Scott, BIS for Mrs Helen Baird at the Norwegian National Specialty and BOS at The Norwegian Specialty for Mr Jürgen Pappenfuss.

During the years we have imported dogs from England and Germany, mainly to suit our own breeding program, but also with the aim to strengthen the bloodlines here in Scandinavia: Ch Eaglescrag Viking, Ch Witchesbroom Hussar, Ch Oelmuehle Atlas Wolftone, Ch Kellybourne Minute Man of Solstrand, Ch Solstrand Elenborough of Kellybourne, Ch Olov von der Oelmühle, Ch Maeverik's Zippy Zodiac, they all became very successful in the show ring and they also had great influence in the breed, here and abroad, as wisely used stud dogs. We are happy & proud that our breeding & the rewarding co-work with other breeders has given the result that dogs with our prefix in the pedigree successfully represent the breed in many parts of the world.

The years went by and nowadays my husband and I are retired. Our family situation does not really allow wolfhounds here at home anymore, I am sad to say. It feels strange after 45 years not to have a wolfhound around, and I miss those active, showing and breeding, days with my heart breed. Our breed here at home these days are whippets, also a wonderful breed and perfect life companions, easy, active and happy!

During the years we have met many fantastic people and dogs; a very true reflection: our best friends and memories in life, we got thanks to the dogs! I am an FCI judge since 1996, and group judge

for all sighthounds. During the years I had the honour to judge Wolfhounds in a lot of countries almost all over the world.

I feel it is not an easy task to fill in for Mr Jim Behan, such a famous and experienced IW person, but I will certainly do my best! Thank you for the invitation - I'm very much looking forward to meet you and your dogs!

Judges' Comments

I want to thank all involved for this very special weekend! It was a long trip for me to travel from Sweden to Vancouver, but I'm so happy that I did!

I met so many friendly people, saw so many beautiful wolfhounds and had a glimpse of this dramatic and majestic landscape.

Also meeting and catching up with old friends and making new ones - a weekend I will always remember!

The show was so well organised in every way: beautiful show-ground, effective ring steward, impressive trophy table, tasty lunch and perfect weather! Most important for a successful show: lovely wolfhounds and friendly, polite exhibitors!

The starting ceremony with the bagpipes, all the dogs going round the ring with their owners and the judges, it gave a special atmosphere and feeling to this show right from the beginning.

As a judge, you have to make your choices in the ring quite quickly. You judge the dog for that day and not everybody can be happy about your decisions, so some are bound to be perhaps a bit disappointed. At this show, I met only good manners and sportsmanship, smiling faces and friendly words. Everybody seemed to have a good time with their dogs, sharing the same interest, just as it should always be!

When I judge wolfhounds I'm looking for big dogs of true sight hound type. One must be able to see the able hunter the breed is meant to be. Strength and beauty in harmony gives the true stamp of quality.

The dogs at this show were all well cared for, most of them happy and outgoing in temperament. I found some of them too long in body. Dogs built on long lines can often have a long stride from the side, but toplines often suffers. My ideal dog keeps the same outline both standing and moving.

I also found some of them lacking in substance and a bit thin in condition. As always; when I'm judging, I give extra attention to breed points like dark eyes and well carried roset ears.

My winning dogs had all what I was looking for: true type, great size and commanding appearance, beautiful proportions and balance, strength and beauty in combination, easy, active movements with drive and soundness and also that special winning attitude.

The day after the show, the club had arranged a meeting and a seminar at Emma Ross's beautiful home. So extraordinary, great hospitality!

Everybody could ask questions and take part in the discussions. We all sat there by the open fire, eating delicious food talking about the breed, so peaceful and relaxing.

We saw the dogs taking turns running in the beautiful surroundings, playing and swimming in the lake just beside us, showing great spirit and happiness, just perfect and so beautiful! To me, this was the highlight of the whole weekend!

Good luck in the future with the Club and your hounds! Take care of the special bonds and friendship in your group, it's rare!

It was 25 years ago that Donna and I were blessed with our first Wolfhound, a puppy bitch from Sam Ewing, Enter-prise Earnait of Eagle We have gone from living with one to three to five to the now, 8-12 adults, plus puppies share our home. At the moment we have ages 2 months, 2 yrs., 4 yrs., 5 yrs., 9 yrs., 10 yrs., at home. Having spent our early years with race horses, we feel it has served us well, as it taught us the interaction of conformation and movement.

Our first Wolfhound taught us what a horrible, heart wrenching, affliction Epilepsy is. No breeding happens at Taliesin without Ann Janis first "running the numbers". Our first imported dog taught us about heart disease. All our dogs are heart tested yearly at Specialties, where the Irish Wolfhound Foundation assists in the cost, making it affordable for large numbers. As breeders we feel there is no excuse for not doing basic testing. Our first "Save" (come get this dog now), taught me how much I love this breed, how forgiving these dogs are. I watched this dog go from not leaving the mudroom, to one evening summoning up the courage to walk out to the living room, just to be near us. One day he picked up a stuffed Turtle that he carried around for nearly 3 years with such pride! Donna accompanied Zany at age 7.5, as he won the National in Carlisle, Pa. Zany taught me how much it means for a dog to have a steady Home. Being loved is where home is. It's important, much more so than a damn ribbon. They give us too much for us not to give them the best we can. We've had but 15 litters in 25 years, with my wonderful wife Donna handling, Taliesin has won many awards. I look forward to meeting you and your hounds, and thank you for the opportunity to touch your Hounds.
